ELECTION INFORMATION FOR ANNUAL ELECTION 2026

The election of a Board of Directors (BOD) will be held in accordance with The ESV Governing Documents. The voting will follow the Annual Meeting on the second Tuesday in February 2026. The time and date of the meeting is February 10, 2026 at 1:30 PM.

CANDIDACY

Any member in good standing, who desires to be a candidate for the BOD, may submit a short resume, including qualifications to be a Director. The resume must be printed on one side only on an 8 ½ x 11 paper and may be mailed or delivered to the EVHA Office, 189 SE Claudia Way. It must be received by 12:00 PM (Noon), December 9, 2025.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

The governing documents permit voting by secret/absentee ballot. This is **only** available to members who are not in attendance at the annual meeting of the members for the election of directors. Such ballots must be placed in the provided inner envelope bearing identifying information reflecting the printed name of the name of the member, the address for which the vote is being cast, and the signature of the owner casting that ballot. No other remarks should be on the ballot. Any other marks will **INVALIDATE** your vote.

A request for an absentee ballot may be submitted to Chairperson Tony Petrovich, by any member of the Association who knows he/she will be away from home on the day of voting. Owners of homes, who reside elsewhere, will be mailed an absentee ballot with 2 return envelopes, as described above.

Absentee Ballots will be accepted until 12:00 PM (Noon) in the Office, February 9th, 2026. Chairperson Tony Petrovich will retain custody of the ballots, which will be opened February 10th, 2026 by the Election Committee only. **NO PROXY BALLOTS.**

ELECTION DAY

All members must bring valid photo ID for authentication to receive an Official Ballot. The completed ballot **MUST** be placed in the ballot box. After the last call for the completed ballots is made, they will then be collected and counted by the Election Committee. Three (3) volunteer members will be allowed to observe (only) the counting of all ballots by the Committee Members. The verified total count is then given to the BOD President to announce the results, posted in clubhouse. Eligible members can only vote in person or by absentee ballot; **NO PROXY BALLOTS.**

CAMPAIGN INTEGRITY Candidates may campaign throughout the Village. Any attempt to influence a vote by coercion or intimidation should be reported to the Election Committee.
